The CBSE Board Results for the year 2019-20 of our school speaks volume of the performance of our school students.

 For the 14th consecutive academic year our school scored a100% result in a One Shot Examination which the CBSE reintroduced after the gap of 8 years and I am very proud to announce that 111 out of 250 students secured high distinction, and 56 merit rankers secured A1 grade. ROHIT RAHORE & KUNAL CHAUDHARY of our school topped with 98% amongst all CBSE schools of Kalyan. In second position was SONAL PATIL & JEEVAN VIRWADEKAR with 97.4%, ZAHRA ZULFIKAR stood third with 97.20%. and with such a great result we can certainly marvel at our academic excellence.

2) External Exams :

The great performance of our students in external competition also establishes the fact that we do not develop mere book worms, but students who have a zest for higher external academic pursuits and goals. Approximately 809 students participated in external exams:-

- i) UNIFIED COUNCIL National Level Talent Science Examination 2020 for VI to std X- Total appeared=113, 13 class topper from std VI to IX, one national rank of Class X
- ii) UNIFIED COUNCIL's International Mathematics Olympiad 2020 for std VI to X= 80 students participated and class toppers=12 from std VI to IX, At National level 1 student and State level 1 student is selected. KUNAL CHAUDHARY has ranked 62nd of the top 100 national achiever

iii) NSTSE Exam

Kunal Chaudhary of class X is declared at rank 40, of the top 100 national achievers in NSTSE exams 2020. Kunal has received cash awards of Rs 1000, from Britannica kid online subscription worth of Rs 2500, medal and certification of appreciation

Other than this national achiever, we have another top 12 students of class 6 to 9 who got medal and certificate of appreciation

Achievements in Sports :

1) International yoga day and week program organised by Maharashtra Yuva Sangh and Brihanmumbai yoga association held on 21st and 27 June 2020 our 3 students participated.

2) Thane <u>Yoga competition</u> organised by Brihanmumbai Thane yoga association held on 19 October 2020 in Kalyan where Miss. Sadhika Suresh secured second place.

3) *Surya namaskar* competition organised by Mumbai yoga district held on 19 February 2021 age group under 14 girls our 3 students had participated.
