Next in the External Examinations.

1) Our students have once again showed commendable performance in the Macmillan examination conducted in Aug. 2010. This examination is conducted by McMillan in coalition with university of new South Wales, Sydney Australia. 85 students appeared in this exam out of which 12 students got credit in Maths and 5 students got credit in computer skills and 1 student Aditi Ghosalkar - std 6^{th} won distinction in Maths. This year also the Macmillan exam was conducted on Aug. 16^{th} 2011 where in 75 students participated. The results of which are awaited.

Every year we conduct the AIEEE (All India Engineering Architecture Entrance Examination and from this year we have been also given the additional responsibility of conducting CTET Entrance test (Central Teachers Eligibility Test) which will be held on 29th Jan 2012, and 720 teachers will be appearing for it at our centre.

Before I move on to the list of achievements in other spheres, I find it imperative to state here, there has been a revolution in CBSE education with the introduction of the Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation system. With CCE, the CBSE has brought about a holistic school education that will engender excellence not only in academics but in every sphere of human endeavor and promote intellectual, social and cultural pursuits among its learners i.e. why now Physical Education, Sports, Work Experience and Performing Arts is considered not as nonscholastic subjects but co-scholastic subjects. So that overall development of learners takes place and they develop into competent, confident and enterprising citizens.

Now let me give you news from the sports corner. Well, truly I must say it has been a memorable year as far as sports is concerned, be it Football, Karate, Swimming, Skating or Cricket.

Firstly the Football highlights
